- ✓ Undertaking projects that demonstrate best practice in supporting children and young people with dyslexia/ specific learning difficulties.

How it works

The project will work in partnership with the Youth Offending Service, Pupil Attendance and Educational Welfare teams and key agencies from Social Inclusion.

Key aspects of the project:

- ✓ A clear, reliable communication system between a young offender's school and Children's Service agencies to encourage joined up thinking and continuity of practice.
- ✓ Literacy intervention to boost reading skills using multi-sensory techniques and assistive technology where necessary.
- ✓ Structured workshop sessions discussing hopes and aspirations with the use of creative skills, discussion, anger management and inspirational guests.
- Cross mapping to other work of national significance to add value to the outcomes.
